

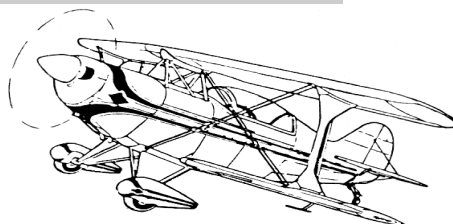

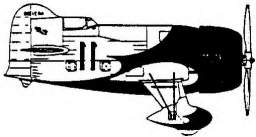

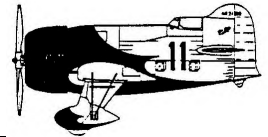
Mowing: In efforts to keep members involved in mowing the facility lawn, Connor has offered to take the paid position of weekly mowing.

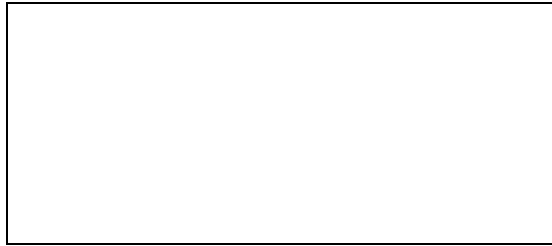
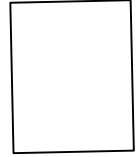
