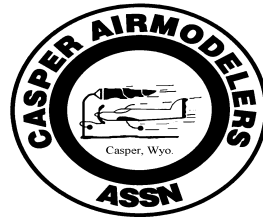
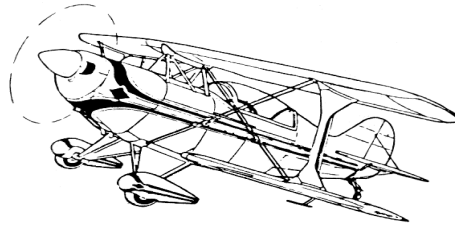

Zobe asked about getting run-out areas sterilized, Ray moved to do so and Stu 2nd.

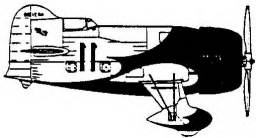
Fred gave a great program on how and where to mount your receiver antenna.

Zobe won the fuel raffle which was covered by ticket purchases.

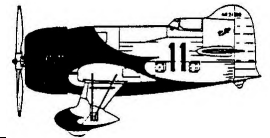
Meeting adjourned.

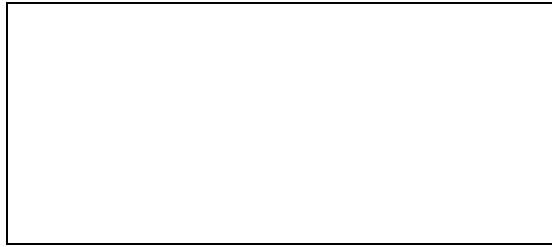
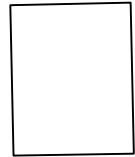
