

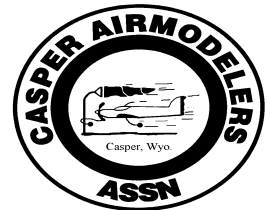
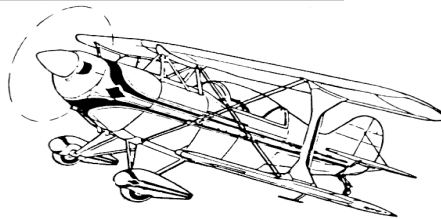

AMA Federal Regs: New federal guidelines require that all RC aircraft over .5lb be registered. AMA is working with the FAA to use existing AMA numbers with this protocol.
