

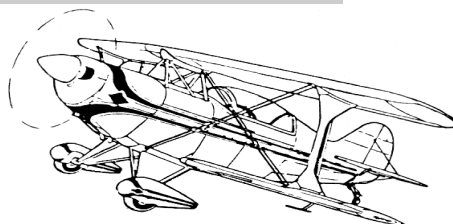

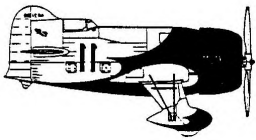
**Roof:** The City of Casper has installed a new metal roof on the shelter- THANK YOU

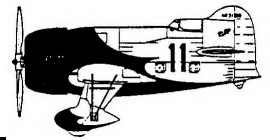
Lynn motioned to adjourn and Bob Palmer made the 2<sup>nd</sup>.

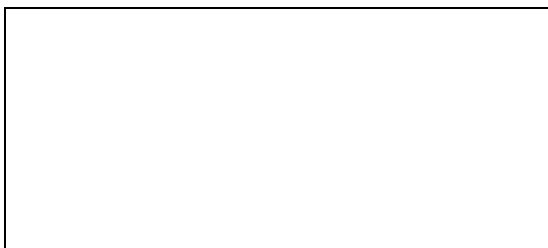
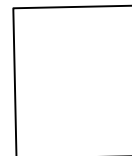
