

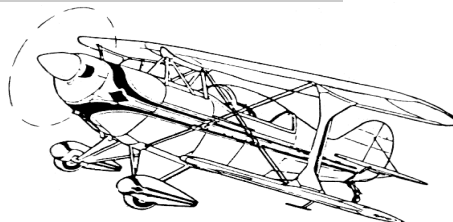

NEW BUSINESS:

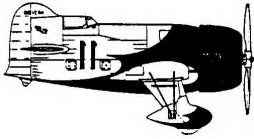
Gary Z. gave us a detailed presentation on how to program your 9303 TX.

Thanks to Gary A lot of good information was gained by all. HE also led discussions about other brands. Again Thanks Gary!

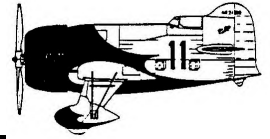
Tom R. had the lucky fuel ticket, the Club made a profit of \$13.00.

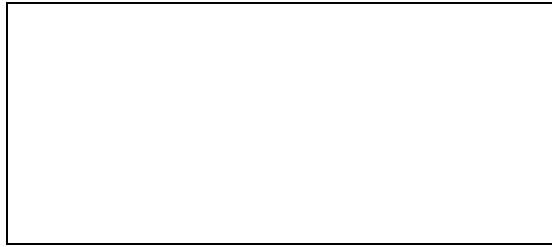
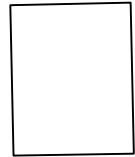
