

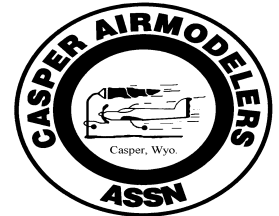
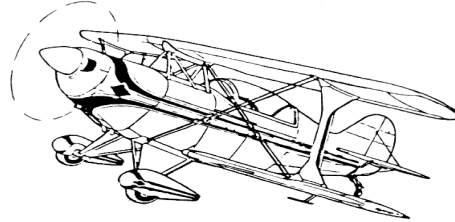

NEW BUSINESS

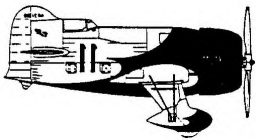

Raffle: Stu has made an offer to donate product(s) for raffle at the fun fly. Thank you! Stu will work with Bob P and Tom regarding items.

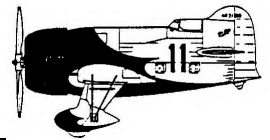
Jerry motioned to adjourn and Fred made the 2nd.

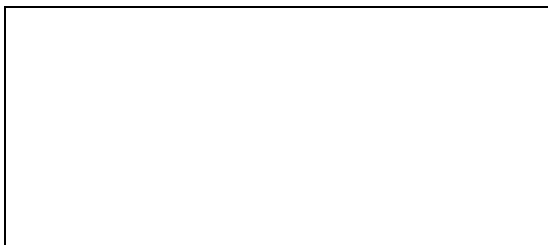
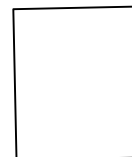
