

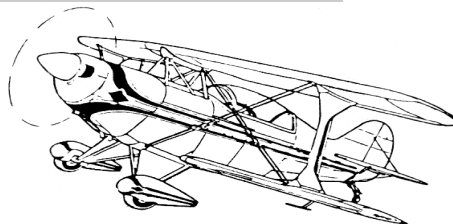

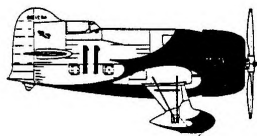

## Casper Airmodelers Association Meeting 9\13\11

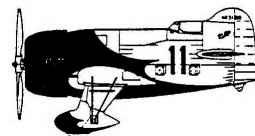
Meeting called to order at 6:31pm by Tom R.

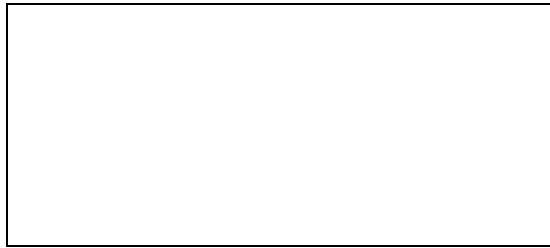
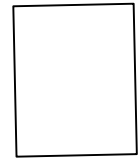
