

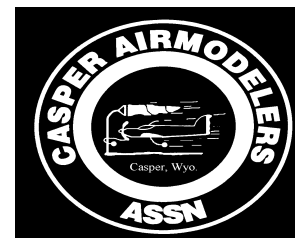
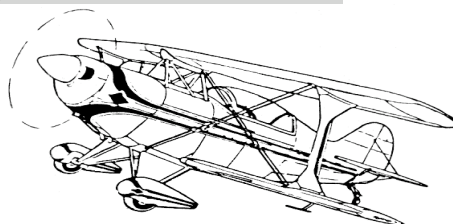
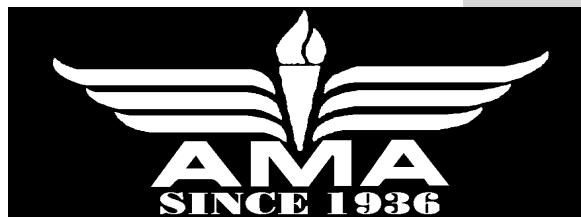

## March 10, 2009 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM with 9 members in present.

Gary Z. motioned and Reed M. 2<sup>nd</sup> that we approve the minutes of the February meeting as published in the newsletter - Passed.

Fred H. motioned and Gary Z. 2<sup>nd</sup> that we approve the treasurers report - Passed.

### Old Business:

Tom R. reported on the progress of the slurry seal for the runways at the field. He had made contact with one of the local contractors (DLH), and they had given him a price of \$1.90 per square yard. Using this figure, Tom calculated that it will take around \$7,700 to complete the project. The AMA has a grant program for such projects, and that they will provide up to a 10% grant for this type of project. Tom was planning on proposing this to the Leisure Board on 3/24 at 16:30.

Gary Z. made a motion, and Fred H. 2<sup>nd</sup> that Tom pursues funding from the city and the AMA with the remainder of the funding (up to \$3000) to come from the Casper Airmodelers pending final approval at a later meeting when we have more details, and more members present.

Reed M. reported that the web site was able to be registered at a significant discount over what was approved in February. This web site is registered at [www.casperairmodelers.com](http://www.casperairmodelers.com) and he is in the process of building it as his time permits.

Reed also reported that Tower Hobbies was happy with the build article that he wrote on the electric airplane that they provided. Dan M. offered a Hitec radio system for this aircraft to make it a complete package for the raffle. A motion was made to make the drawing for this raffle at the 4<sup>th</sup> of July flying.

#### **New Business:**

Abe K reported that the Gun club was in the process of asking the city for more land, east of the current barriers. This area that they are asking for should not encroach into our flying area, but Abe was asked to get more details to be discussed at a later meeting.

Bob S, made a motion and Reed M. 2<sup>nd</sup> that we adjourn.
