

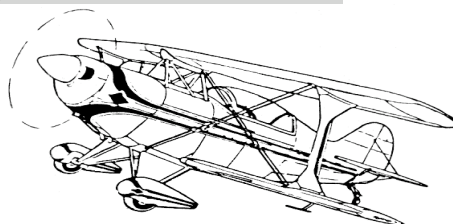

Pre Flight Safety: Fred H. took the time to draft an updated checklist for pre flight inspections that could eliminate a lot of potential incidents. This list is available in the tower at the facility. If you are going to maiden an aircraft, please use this list as a reference and contact other members for inspection and help.

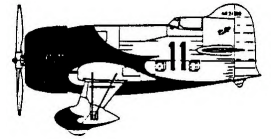
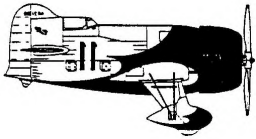

I have a pair of orange handled pliers that I picked up off the starting bench last weekend, let me know if they are yours.

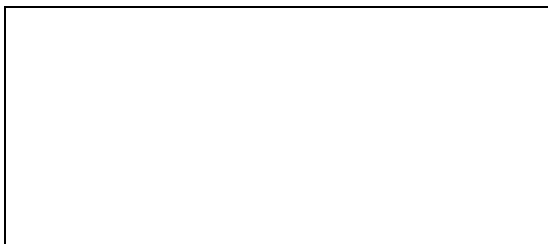
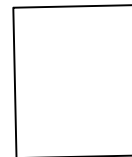
